seen on Discover Live Steam and is in "new" condition. Some of the many upgraded and added details include;

1. denim roof covering 2. coupler pockets 3. upper ladder platforms 4. wooden porch deck and stairs 5. cupola window bars 6. Tom Bee trucks with operational simulated leaf springs 7. glad hand safety chains 8. undercarriage toolbox 9. hinged opening doors 10. lower cabin exterior steel reinforcement plates 11. "club rules" safety chains 12.9 to 12 volt working marker lights 13. toilet vent cover plate 14. working remote coupler bars on Tom Bee couplers 15. removable cabin, bolted to steel frame 16. end frame channel caps Interior is painted light green and awaits your details, or can be left as is. It has been around the Illinois Live Steamers railroad layout a few times behind my train and tracks extremely well. Since then it has been stored in my climate controlled work shop. At this location (60463) is where it would have to be picked up. Crating and shipping is a NO-NO on this one.




## **Current Track Configuration**



Editor's note

This spring a large project was undertaken at the park. The double track bridge needed to have the ties re-L placed. Five hundred of new rail was purchased, and a culvert was replaced. The old lumber and grating was removed and replaced with new treated lumber. The deck of the bridge will be covered to allow a lawn mower to cross. At the same time, the diamond at Latimer was removed and is being replaced. The track on the "Y" curve was removed and is being replaced with double track for a passing siding . all track was relayed with new ties. This will allow more options for running bi-directional. Some signals have been added and the plan is to have signals around the whole track in the next few years. We will have blocks that are claimed and released. Thanks to all who helped and to those who supplied equipment for the project.
